## Purim Message from Rabbi Arthur Schneier

“Remember what *Amalek* did to you” – Devarim 25:17

**WE REMEMBER** Haman’s determination for a “Final Solution,” the destruction of the Jewish people, sadly, this ancient hatred of anti-Semitism is widespread in Europe and the United States. For the first time in the United States, we were confronted with “Hate Day” on Saturday, February 25th by white supremacists that rallied antisemites to use propaganda, banner drops, and graffiti to further their hatred against Jews.

Queen Esther at first was reluctant to intervene with her husband King Ahashverosh to overrule Haman’s verdict until warned by Mordechai, her uncle that she will not be spared if Haman’s plan of extinction comes to fruition. Ultimately, her intervention reversed the verdict, Haman and his sons were hanged and the Jews survived.

An important lesson for our days. We cannot afford to be indif-

ferent when conspiracy theories, Holocaust denials and anti-Zionism is dispensed daily. Silence aids the perpetrators. Let us learn from the experience of our ancestors for the present challenges Jewish communities are facing.

The month of Adar is a time for enhanced joy. Reliance on the Divine Promise “I will dwell among the children of Israel, and will not forsake my people Israel.” (1 Kings 6:13) He is the Shomer Yisrael, the Guardian of Israel. He needs our partnership to ensure Am Israel Chai!

Elisabeth joins me in Chag Purim Sameach. May your hearts and homes be blessed with peace and joy.



Spring brings us a lot of joy and light! What can be more joyful than our favorite Jewish holidays Purim and Pesach?



## Bedikat Chametz

**T**HIS YEAR the search for chametz will take place on Tuesday April 4 after 8:00 p.m. All homes should be cleansed of chametz before the search. After sundown the search for any leftover chametz takes place. This search is customarily done with a candle but contemporary authorities instruct us to use electric lights as well to ensure that no crumb escapes our sight. The head of the household renounces possession of all Chametz unknown to him/her remaining in the house.

## Fast of the Firstborn

**A**LL FIRST-BORN MALES are to fast as an expression of gratitude to G-d who spared the Jewish first-born when their Egyptian counterparts were slain. Participation in a siyum, the completion of the study of a Talmudic tractate, is accepted in lieu of fasting. On Wednesday, April 5 morning services will take place at 7:30 a.m. followed by the siyum, the traditional biur chametz, the burning of the chametz, will take place on Wednesday, April 5, third – floor terrace, no later than 11:45 a.m.

## Shmurah Matzah

**T**HERE IS A SPECIAL MITZVAH to eat Shmurah Matzah on Passover, particularly for the Seders. Shmurah Matzah is under Rabbinical supervision from the time of harvesting until packaging. Congregants can order this special Matzah through the Synagogue office. Orders may be placed online. The cost of the Matzah is \$30 per pound package. We can only accept orders for two or more pounds. Orders must be placed by Friday, March 24.
