DAM DAVIS and his family joined the Park East community in 2021 when Adam and his wife, Wendy, enrolled their son, Ari, in the Rabbi Arthur Schneier Park East Day School. They chose RASPEDS to provide Ari with a strong Jewish identity and community enriched with Jewish tradition, an experience that Adam didn't have growing up in a small town in Ohio. In just a few years, because of the caring teachers, robust curriculum, Toby's Children Service and the overall welcoming environment, the Park East community has become a focal point for the family. With each year, their appreciation and support has grown.

Adam moved to New York City in 1996. He devoted his 33-year career to commercial real estate, with the last 19 years at Wells Fargo in varous leadership roles building several lending businesses. Adam retired from Wells Fargo in 2019 as the head of a commercial real estate lending, securitization and loan servicing business with \$25 billion in assets and 1,200 team members in the United States, United Kingdom and India. He left the business world to become a fulltime at-home father and partner with Wendy in raising their son. Besides his son, Adam enjoys genealogy, which has led to special relationships and meaningful discoveries. He is also an exercise junky and active president of his co-op board.

ABBI HAROLD EINSIDLER has been an essential part of the Park East community for more than five decades. Rabbi Einsidler, who studied at CUNY and was ordained at Yeshiva Rabbi Samson Raphael Hirsch, is the Ritual Director of Park East Synagogue, Principal of the Leon and Gina Fromer Youth Enrichment Center, and instructor at the Rabbi Arthur Schneier Park East Day School. Under his tutelage, hundreds of children have learned Torah and Talmud. Rabbi Harold Einsidler conducts the Friday Oneg Shabbat programs for the day school students. Our children enjoy singing Shabbat songs and analyzing the parsha with exciting discussions. The one-on-one attention that he gives to each Bar or Bat Mitzvah ensures that all of our children shine at their special moments. Each year, our students eagerly await his presentation on shofar, the model seder, and other special programs that he conducts. Rabbi Harold Einsidler's adult education programming consists of his popular Tuesday Bible class and Shabbat afternoon parsha class, which are well-attended and are the mainstay of our adult education program.

SIDORE KARTEN, known as "Izzy," embodies a rich heritage deeply rooted in the Park East Synagogue community; growing up as an alumnus of the school and maintaining a legacy spanning three generations. His familial

ties to Park East are steeped in unwavering support, as exemplified by his father and grandfather, after whom he is named. Isidore Karten Sr. not only survived the Holocaust but fought back as a partisan in the forest, and alongside his brothers, saved hundreds of lives. At age 19, Izzy enlisted in the Israel Defense Forces (IDF), serving as a combat soldier in the Nahal Brigade. This choice was motivated by a profound desire to follow in the footsteps of his maternal uncle, Sharone Edry, a fallen hero who had also served with distinction in the Nahal Brigade. Following his honorable discharge from the IDF, Izzy continued his education at Columbia University, pursuing a degree in Architecture, with a specialized focus on Real Estate Development and Finance. Today, he holds the position of Head of US Acquisitions and Asset Management at Skyway Equities, whose primary holdings include majority and controlling stakes in both Fibra HD (BMV: FIBRHD15) and Fibra Plus (BMV: FPLUS16). Outside of his professional endeavors, Izzy dedicates his free time to leadership and organization within the Jewish community. He is particularly passionate about curating and spearheading Jewish events tailored to young professionals throughout the Upper East Side and Manhattan. In the spirit of tradition and unity, Izzy eagerly anticipates the privilege and honor of addressing the congregation as Chatan Torah. in Manhattan.
