Purim Message from Rabbi Arthur Schneier

THE STORY OF PURIM describes the victory over Haman, descendant of Amalek, our perennial enemy throughout history.

descendant of Amalek, our perennial enemy throughout history. Haman, the epitome of disbelief in G-d, was able to seize power and almost wiped out the Jews entirely.

Jewish destiny is linked to the moon, which has eight lunar phases: new moon, waxing crescent, first quarter, waxing gibbous, full moon, waning gibbous, third quarter and waning crescent. As Jewish people we were on our way to a full moon upon creation of the State of Israel but this dream was shattered on October 7th, when the world changed.

Amalek is still alive today. The Massacre of October 7th has posed a serious danger to the security of Israel and has unleashed global anti-Semitism and anti-Zionism around the world like we have not witnessed for generations, a devastating concern for Jews everywhere. We cannot remain silent; we must act in the face of widespread conspiracy theories and old anti-Semitic tropes, demonizing Israel and the Jewish people in the news and on social media, and Holocaust denial and even denial of October 7th. United We Prevail, Divided We Fail.

Amalek will never prevail. Am Yisrael Chail The Divine Promise "I will dwell among the children of Israel, and will not forsake my people Israel." (1 Kings 6:13)," will stand strong.

Bedikat Chametz

THIS YEAR the search for chametz will take place on Sunday, April 21 after 8:30 p.m. All homes should be cleansed of chametz before the search. After sundown the search for any leftover chametz takes place. This search is customarily done with a candle but contemporary authorities instruct us to use electric lights as well to ensure that no crumb escapes our sight. The head of the household renounces possession of all Chametz unknown to him/her remaining in the house.

Fast of the Firstborn

ALL FIRST BORN MALES are to fast as an expression of gratitude to G-d who spared the Jewish firstborn when their Egyptian counterparts were slain. Participation in a siyum, the completion of the study of a Talmudic tractate, is accepted in lieu of fasting. On Monday, April 22, morning services will take place at 7:30 a.m. followed by the siyum, and the traditional biur chametz, the burning of the chametz, will take place on the first floor playground, no later than 11:45 a.m.

Shmurah Matzah

THERE IS A SPECIAL MITZVAH to eat Shmurah Matzah on Passover, particularly for the Seders. Shmurah Matzah is under Rabbinical supervision from the time of harvesting until packaging. Congregants can order this special Matzah through the Synagogue office. Orders may be placed online. The cost of the Matzah is \$35 per pound package. Orders must be placed by Friday, April 5.




